## Teamwork Self-Reflection Instrument (TSRI) Script for Classroom Administration

I was invited to your class today to administer the Teamwork Self-Reflection Instrument, TSRI for short. We are using the TSRI to help us collect more information regarding student teamwork skills

The instrument you will be given is in its early stages of development. You will notice at the top of the page that you are asked for your name and Sam ID number. There is no foreseeable risk or harm to you for participating in this assessment. At this time we are simply collecting data to see if this works. All collected data will be used in aggregate. Your participation in this assessment is purely voluntary.

The TSRI is a reflection of how you behave as a team member, preferably in classes at SHSU. If you have not yet participated in any group activities at SHSU, then answer the questions based on any prior teamwork experiences. You are to reflect upon your experiences as a whole, not necessarily just one experience. The idea is to capture a sense of your general perceptions of your actions and behaviors in a team setting. As you are reading through each grouping, take care to read your choices all the way across before answering, as you will notice there are parallel sentence structures with some variability. You may check options in different boxes – that is ok – there are no wrong answers!

Before you get started, be sure to write your name and Sam ID at the top, then turn the page over to complete the demographic questions on the back. It should not take you more than 15 minutes to complete this assessment.
