## **Guidelines for Proposal Submission, Evaluation, and Acceptance**

### **Concurrent Session Format**

- 50-minute Session
- Classroom Style Setting
- Projector and Screen Provided

### **Submission Guidelines**

All proposals should be submitted to [jeff.roberts@shsu.edu](mailto:jeff.roberts@shsu.edu). The proposal should be submitted as a Microsoft Word document and is required to have all of the following elements:

- Title of the session
- Conference Track for the session
- Abstract providing a brief description of the session (100 words or less) for inclusion in the program
- An extended description of the session providing information about the larger significance of the session (500-750 words or less)
- Brief biographical sketch(es) of the presenter(s)

### **Evaluation of Proposals**

Each proposal will be reviewed by a minimum of two reviewers, and will be evaluated in the following areas:

- The overall quality of the proposal.
- The potential for replication of the information being presented within the session by others.



- The potential relevance and impact of the information being presented upon the higher education community.
- Qualifications of the presenters.

### **Acceptance of Proposals**

Received proposals will be reviewed on a rolling basis. Presenters will be notified of their proposal's acceptance within two weeks of being received. All primary and co-presenters are expected to register for the conference and are responsible for their own registration fee, travel, and lodging.
